Program Name: Cultural Resources Management Graduate Certificate

This program is designed to be completed in 1 year.

Completion time is based on taking 6 credits per semester in the fall, spring and summer semesters.

This program will cost in-state residents \$6,680 if completed within normal time. It will cost out-of-state residents \$7,886.

These costs include tuition, required fees, any additional required course fees, and any book and supply costs. Any courses taken online will have an additional \$35 per credit hour charge. There may be additional costs for living expenses. These costs used the Fall 2019 posted tuition and fee rates (see <http://uar.nmsu.edu/tuition-rates/>) and were accurate at the time of posting, but may have changed.

This graduate certificate is an eligible graduate program under the Western Regional Graduate Program (WRGP). Residents of Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, U.S. Pacific Territories and Freely Associate States, Utah, Washington, and Wyoming are eligible to attend this program at NMSU for in-state tuition rates.
