Program Name: Public Health Graduate Certificate

This program is designed to be completed in 1 year.

Completion time is based on taking 6 credits in the fall and spring semesters, and 3 credits in the summer.

The on-campus program will cost in-state residents \$5,509 if completed within normal time. It will cost out-of-state residents \$6,514.

The online program will cost all students \$6,708 if completed within normal time.

These costs include tuition, required fees, any additional required course fees, and any book and supply costs. For students in the on-campus program, any courses taken online will have an additional \$35 per credit hour charge. There may be additional costs for living expenses. These costs used the Fall 2019 posted tuition and fee rates (see <http://uar.nmsu.edu/tuition-rates/>) and were accurate at the time of posting, but may have changed.

Median Debt of 2017-18 Normal Time Completers: Fewer than 10 students completed this program in 2017-18. Thus, the median debt of the normal time completers has been withheld to preserve the confidentiality of the students.
